

When to stay home, when to return, and what action to take:

Exposure or Positive Test

Student has been exposed to a COVID positive person for more than 15 sustained minutes

A member of the household is positive, awaiting test results, or experiencing symptoms

- > Stay home
- > Call your doctor
- > Doctor determines start date of mandatory 14-day quarantine
- > Inform Brightonview Montessori

Symptoms WITHOUT Known Exposure

Student is experiencing COVID-like symptoms*

Student has a fever of 100 degrees fahrenheit or higher

- > Stay home
- > Call your doctor
- > Inform Brightonview Montessori
- > Rest & recover for 10 days OR
- > Provide documentation of a negative test result

Ready to Return

Student has been fever-free without medication for 72 hours and 10 days have passed since the first symptom OR has a negative COVID test

- > Return to school!

**COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. Infected people have had a wide range of symptoms reported – from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. Symptoms include:*

*Fever or chills | Cough | Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing | Fatigue | Muscle or body aches | Headache
New loss of taste or smell | Sore throat | Congestion or runny nose | Nausea or vomiting | Diarrhea*
